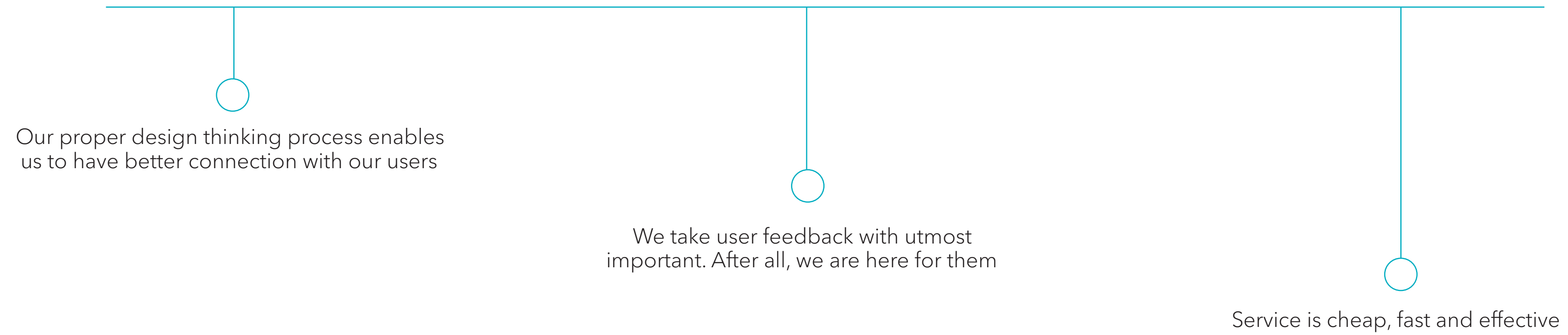
Mama Khya
