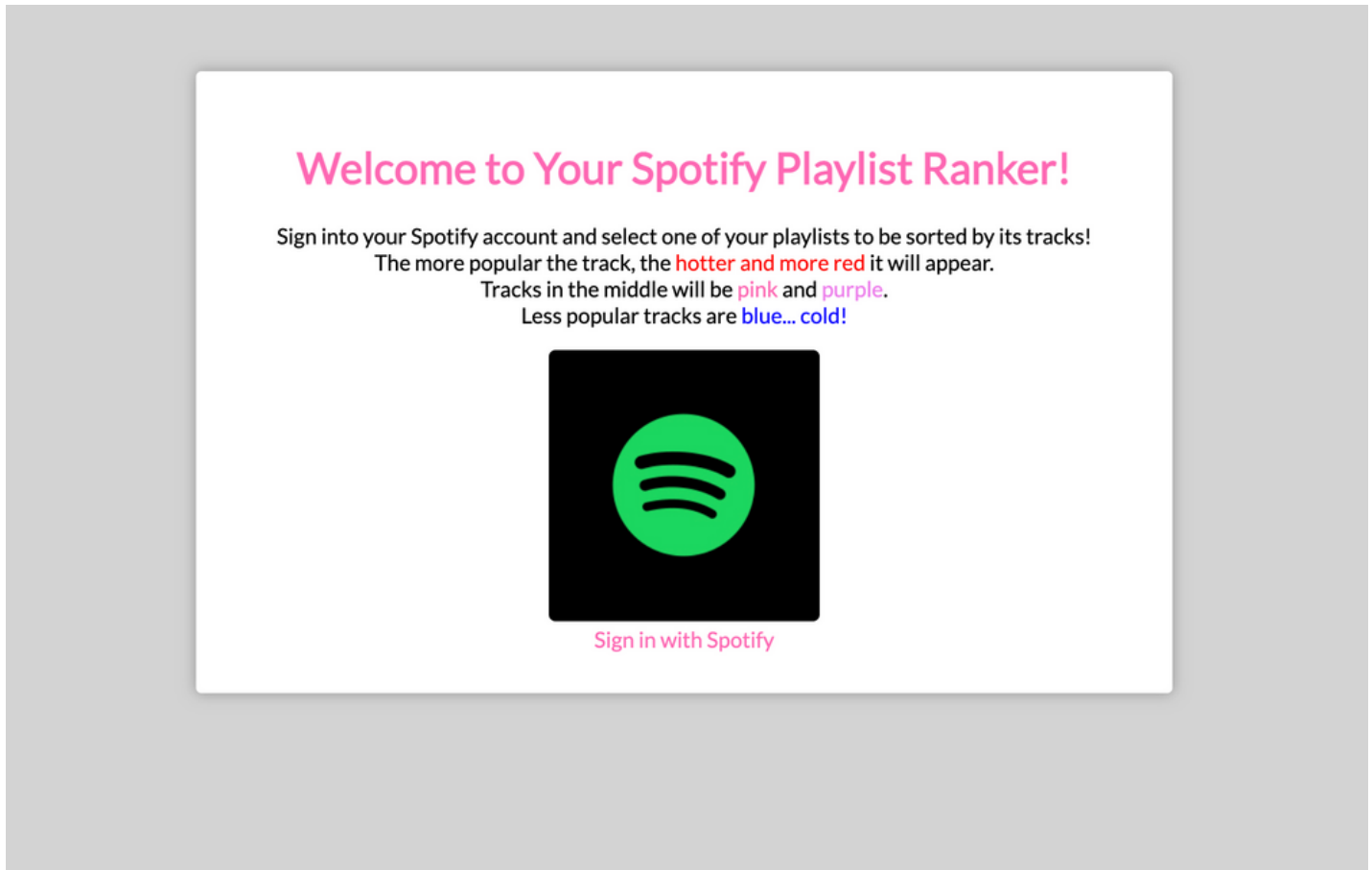




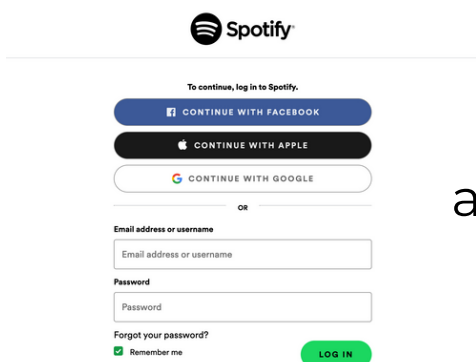

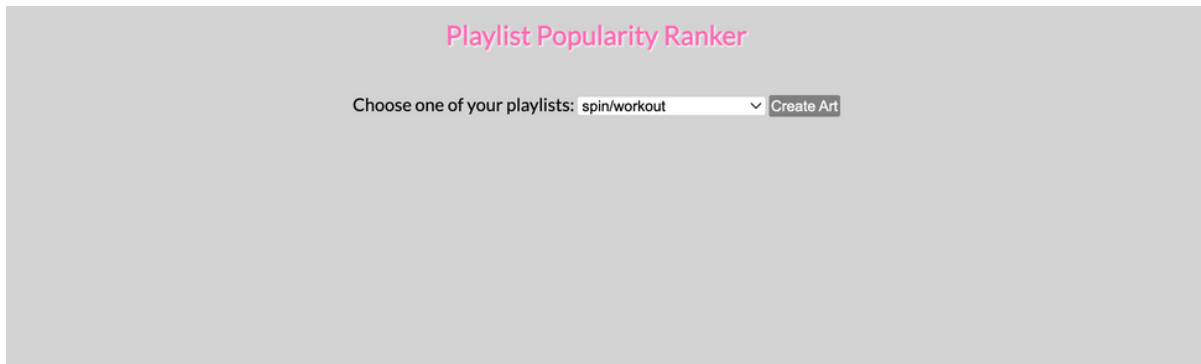


The "Sign in With Spotify" link takes users to Spotify's own authorization page.



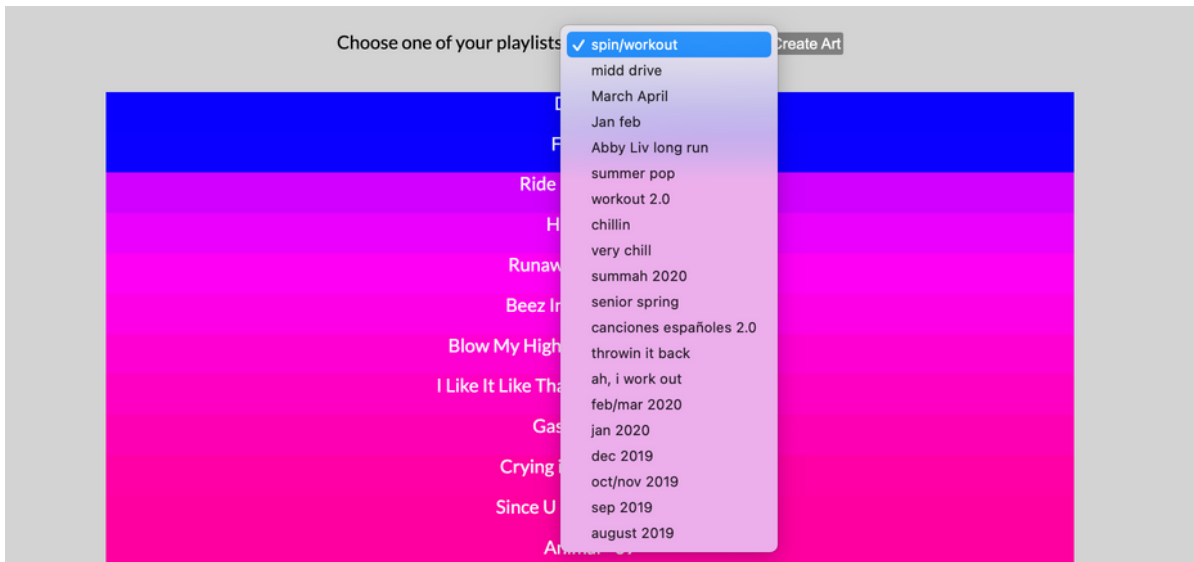
The first time a user logs in they are asked to allow the "Assignment 4" Spotify app created for this project to access their account.

Quirks to Know If Testing

Clicking the button on this page gives a cross-origin OAuth error due to the fact that it redirects to `/auth/spotify`. If we had time to redo, I'd change the page that the playlist spectrum appears on!

FIX:

Simply go to `localhost:3000/auth/spotify` again to see your playlist spectrum.

Another quirk: last searched playlist is auto loaded from database when `/auth/spotify` path is used, so you can open the page to a playlist model before searching one if there are any playlists in the database
