



ESSENTIAL SYSADMIN COMMANDS

- 1) **chroot** (change root directory of a process, or commands)
- 2) **ddrescue** (recover data from damaged or corrupted devices)
- 3) **auditd** (manage the linux audit system)
- 4) **journalctl** (system logs, monitor system activity)
- 5) **glances** (monitor system processes, and resource usage)
- 6) **xargs** (used to pass a list of files or arguments to a command)
- 7) **strace** - (to diagnose program crashes, and security issues)
- 8) **traceroute** (trace what route packets take from one network to another)
- 9) **ping** (see if a network is online, & measure the trip-time)
- 10) **systemctl** (manage the linux system daemons)
- 11) **ifconfig** (configure & display network interfaces)
- 12) **df** (monitor disk usage)
- 13) **rsync** (transfer files over a network. Update backups, mirror websites)
- 14) **wget** (download files from the internet (batch download/mirror websites)
- 15) **tail** (display the last few lines of file. - good for log files)
- 16) **diff** (compare two different files, & display the differences)
- 17) **patch** (apply a patch file to a specific file or directory)
- 18) **tar** (create or manipulate archives, also used to compress/decompress)
- 19) **awk** (search for patterns, extract fields from structured data)
- 20) **head** (display the top few lines of file)
